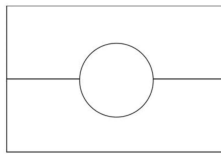

We serve food and drinks on the lands of the Ngunnawal and Ngambri people, whose land and sovereignty was never ceded.

We acknowledge these Traditional Custodians and pay respect to Elders past, present and emerging, of the lands on which we work and live. We further acknowledge and pay respect to the Traditional Custodians of the lands upon which the following beverages were grown, made, packed, shipped, and poured.

We recognise that Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples hold knowledge about connection to country - land, sky and water - that has been practised for thousands of generations. Their cultures and customs have nurtured, and continue to nurture this land. We also recognise that despite efforts to supporting sustainable and forward thinking growers, grape growing will always be a luxury monoculture foreign to this landscape, and as such we recognise the deep debt we are in to the Traditional Custodians of this country, and the lands beneath our feet.

All of it is delicious and exciting for various reasons, the following pages hold a list of the things we're most excited about.

All of it is fun, not all of it is serious.

Despite that, there are a few things that we always take seriously, they are:

Wine should be accessible, not used to create exclusion or draw boundaries of superiority.

We always endeavour to support and showcase small independent producers occupying the marginal spaces in the greater world of beverages.

Wine is an agricultural product, and as such we choose to only list drinks from people who work to improve the land they occupy. This means organic/biodynamic farming (certified or not), or other practices more culturally entwined where these concepts have less relevance.

All the following beverages have been *made*, and so some intervention was necessary. We do however prioritise 'lo-fi' or 'minimal intervention' makers who eschew sugar and acid additives, use native yeasts, and minimise sulphur additions as a means of highlighting the unique places, people, and practices of where they are.

There is always something new, often these are things that are old or once forgotten, sometimes they are truly innovative. This is what keeps the world that supplies the beverages listed here exciting, engaging, and a great place to be.

There is a lot of profound and profoundly weird wine out there, so if you're unsure just ask.

Also it's all yum.

In a ramshackle barn in Burgundy, he's creating some of the most thoughtful and engaging wild ales that speak of a curious mind and a commitment to place. Aged in old wine, spirit, and fortified casks, using only heritage grains and wild-foraged hops, as well as fruit, grapes, and wildflowers from likeminded growers, these unique ales are some of the most exciting and unique drinks we've ever come across.

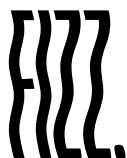


Champagne (The Method).

Method Traditionelle (also referred to as Method Champenoise) is the technique developed in, and exported from, Champagne via merchants in the 18th Century. So basically Champagne but not FROM Champagne. Double fermentation, with long ageing on lees in bottle and varying levels of complexity, character, and dosage. Ranging from lean, sharp, and crystalline through to opulent, oxidative, and rich. Serious gear here.
